Junior players may compete in both the junior and senior divisions, provided the maximum allowed number of entries are not exceeded. Cadet players may compete in both Cadet and Junior Competition, provided maximum allowed entries are not exceeded.

The AKU reserves the right to combine weight categories in the event of low participation numbers. The elimination system to be used for the African Championship in all divisions will be the loser's pool. Weight categories with 5 or less players will be conducted in Round Robin System All entries must be submitted on the **attached Microsoft excel sheet to** allow for the seamless import of entries into the draw program.

Entry Deadlines:

- Entry Numbers: Submit entries by number by June 20, 2025, to ensure sufficient accommodation. (Please submit the accommodation and transport request form.)
- Entries by Name: The final date for submitting entries by name and passport copies is July 4, 2025, to ensure timely receipt of your visa support letter. (Please complete the application form.)

Visa Requirements:

You are responsible for making your own visa arrangements and covering the associated costs. Individuals requiring a visa for South Africa must apply at their nearest South African embassy. Please note that NO VISAS ARE AVAILABLE ON ARRIVAL.

For federations requiring a **visa** to enter South Africa, the last date for a visa support letter request is **28 days before entry** into South Africa. Kindly complete the designated form and submit with passport copies to the following email address <u>kurashsouthafrica@gmail.com</u> (WhatsApp - +27 824585556). Persons traveling by road between bordering countries must ensure that they meet the visa requirements if applicable.

Final list of entries per federation (Excel Application form) must be sent to AKU president at thomasdunker@mweb.co.za and the AKU Sport Director darrenlouw4@gmail.com not later than 04 July 2025 on the prescribed Excel entry form.

Awards: Medals and certificates will be awarded to the 1st, 2nd, and 3rd place winners.

Participation Fee: \$50 USD per person (\$25 to the host federation and \$25 to the African Kurash Union).

REFEREE AND COACHING SEMINAR / COURSE

The Referee Seminar will be under the guidance of Mr. Teddy Rita, our AKU acting Referee Director, on 08 August 2025.

A Practical Coaching Course will be conducted by the IKI for coaches on 07 and 08 August 2025. IKA 'B' Level exam is possible for interested coaches.

A 5-Line Continental and 1 Star Referee Exam and Level 'B' Coaching Exam can be scheduled upon request for those who are interested.

WSP SELECTION AND REGULATIONS

All Senior weight categories that will be contested for the grand prize tournament of the Uzbekistan President are:

- MALE
 - o -60kg, -66kg, -73kg, -81kg, -90kg, -100kg, -120kg +120kg
- FEMALE
 - o -48kg, -52kg, -57kg, -63kg, -70kg, -78kg, -87kg +87kg

For the WSP final event in Uzbekistan all the costs are covered, including visa, flight, and accommodation for the selected athletes.

WSP requirements: 5 countries per weight category must compete to qualify for WSP Finals

CONTINENTAL REFEREE EXAM

- Continental referee exam (5 Lines) \$50 payable at accreditation & 1 Star \$200 payable to IKA
- Referee exams are taken during the championship.
- Level 'B' coaching exam \$200 payable to IKA
- Entries will be taken on the 4th July 2025
- Certificates will be issued to successful candidates

FLIGHTS AND TRANSPORT DETAILS

- For all delegations, flights are at your own cost.
- Transport between the hotel and **OR Tambo International Airport** is provided by the hotel shuttle (arrival and departure)
- Transport for all players and officials between the hotel and the venue will be provided daily
- Travel costs for invited referees and AKU directing committee may be paid by the host federation and the AKU. (Partially or fully)

- The price **per person** per day includes breakfast and dinner, quoted in US dollars.
- Accommodation in the tournament hotel is mandatory for all participants.
- A third meal (Lunch) is available for lunch at an additional cost of \$7 per day per person.

• **Subsidised Accommodation:**

- Federations participating in the African Championships with at **least 3 athletes** will receive 1 room sleeping 2 athletes free for **1 day only** in the official hotel.
- Invited officials and AKU directing committee members will also be allocated accommodation in the hotel. Based on 2 persons sharing a room. (Persons requiring a single room or wishing to stay in another hotel are responsible for the difference in cost.)
- Anyone not booking accommodation by the deadline date must pay the normal hotel rates.
- Federations are responsible for all bookings and **non-arrivals** not cancelled one week before the event, and will be invoiced for the balance accordingly.
- Kindly complete the attached accommodation request.
- All delegations and guests are responsible for their own accommodation costs.

DOPING CONTROL

Doping control in all weight categories will be done with the cooperation of the National Anti-Doping Agency (NADO) in accordance with WADA guidelines.

GENERAL CONDITIONS

General Conditions:

- All players must be citizens of the country they represent in order to compete.
- The draw will be conducted automatically one day before the competition in accordance with the rules and regulations of IKA.
- Refugees will be allowed to participate under the following conditions:
 - o Refugee passport or travel document
 - o All refugees, even from different countries, will be sorted under "REFUGEE"
 - Where entries exceed the maximum number of entries, there will be an elimination round first, before being entered in the final draw.

LIABILITY

- (1) Neither the AKU, nor Kurash South Africa shall hold any liability in case of injury or any personal loss experienced by the delegates throughout their visit.
- (2) All delegates and participants are liable for their own insurance.
- (3) Kindly observe if any COVID 19 protocols during your journey are applicable. There are currently no restrictions in South Africa

RULES OF THE KURASH COMPETITION

- (1) The International Kurash Association rules will govern the championship.
